Governors' Update

The Full Governing Body had their spring term meeting last week. The focus of Governors is always about the well-being of pupils and ensuring that they receive the best possible education. With this in mind, one of our Parent Governors, Amanda Burchett, wrote a letter on behalf of the Governing Body to Damien Hinds, MP for East Hampshire. We expressed our on-going concern about the new assessment tests and the negative impact that they were having on many pupils, particularly in Year 6. His reply said that he 'appreciated our concerns' and he acknowledged that the change to primary assessment has not been 'insignificant'.

All Governors at Herne are linked with a subject from the curriculum and meet with the school's subject leaders in order to review action plans. These plans are linked to our broader School Improvement Plan. At last week's meeting reports from these subject visits were highlighted and discussed with a view to monitoring and checking on the school's continued progress. As always, Governors are keen to know the views of parents about the school and interested to see comments from parents through our Twitter feed, emails into the school and written or verbal feedback to the team. *Mary Fair (Chair of Governors)*

Ruling on Term-Time Holidays

The Supreme Court ruled yesterday against the parent who took his daughter out of school in term time. In her judgement, Lady Hale, who was presiding over the hearing, said it would cause 'unacceptable disruption if parents were able to withdraw children (from school) whenever they wanted.' Herne already liaises with other Cluster Schools in Petersfield, particularly Petersfield Infant School and TPS in order to reach a consistent approach with families where children attend different schools locally. We will wait for further guidance from Hampshire County Council and then update parents accordingly.

Dad Ollie Ward of legendary 2 Para, and mum Holly Robinson, have barely left her hospital bedside in the past five weeks.
