New Website Concern - MooMoo.io



MooMoo.io is becoming a favourite amongst many of our pupils and we wanted to make you aware of a few concerns. The main aim of the game (which is still under development) is to collect resources and increase your 'age'. You do this by killing other members and gathering gold/wood etc. A player chooses a server to play on, which are named after locations around the world, and can use a key code to invite

other members to join them. It also has an **unlimited Chat facility**. Users are not required to create a profile ensuring anonymity and there is no reporting feature for users to report abuse. We wanted to also draw your attention to the Terms and Privacy details, which are very limited in content. With this in mind, we have blocked the website in school.
