

Changes to the Self-Isolation Period if You Test Positive for COVID-19

From Monday 17th January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace. If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest. Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.

It kicks-off on 6th January 2022 and runs for eight weeks, until the end of the spring half-term. Why not encourage your pupils to take part?

Let parents and carers know they can join in through the [Hampshire Libraries Kids' Zone](#) or at their local library.

Children can read or listen to any **four** books to complete the challenge. This includes books they read or listen to for school, with family members and friends over Zoom, bedtime stories, non-fiction books, eBooks and audiobooks. Those who visit their local library will be given a collector's card and each time they finish a book they will be able to collect a sticker. 
