

Year 4 Knowledge Organiser Computing – Digital Creativity

What I should already know.

- Use ICT to select and record voice and sounds (e.g. Dictaphone, digital voice recorder, Sound recorder in IWB software).
- Use recorded sound files in other applications.
- Locate and use sound files from Internet, CD ROM, learning platform and Multimedia software (e.g. IWB software).
- Select, import and edit existing sound files in sound editing software (e.g. Audacity).
- Use music software to experiment capturing, repeating and reordering sound patterns.
- Use ICT to create and perform sounds or music that would otherwise not be possible live – e.g. playing a multi-part piece or a very fast piece.

What will I know by the end of the unit?

- Acquire, store and retrieve images from cameras, scanners and the internet and begin to use paint packages or photomanipulation software to change an image (e.g. apply different effects).
- Begin to independently capture, store, retrieve and edit a digital image.
- Develop greater control over the digital stills video camera and use the enhanced tools (Macro, Landscape, Zoom).
- Discuss and evaluate the quality of their own and others' captured images and make decisions (e.g. keep, delete, change).
