#### Absence from school:

Herne wants all children to have a positive experience of school life and be able to reach their full potential. One way in which parents can help their child to do this is by ensuring they attend school every day.

Recently, we've had a couple of parents querying the LA fine as both parents have been fined for the same absence. Please be aware that if your child has 10 or more unauthorised absences (5 days) within a 10- week school week period, we are obliged to issue a penalty notice on behalf of Hampshire County Council. Each Penalty notice is £80 per parent, per child, if paid within 21 days of the date of posting and £160 if paid after this but within 28 days of the date of posting. In some cases, where parents share parental responsibility, we have been asked why the County issue 2 fines. This is because you are both consenting to the child being absent, even if only 1 parent has booked the holiday. Hope this helps to understand the system. It can be confusing.
