We discussed Sexism, with the same approach that we take for Racism and Homophobia. and encouraged our children to think carefully about bias and stereotyping. It tied in well with our current value - Honesty.

On Monday afternoon, I judged the **Choral Speaking** task that had been set as our Book Week Challenge. The children performed in House Teams in each Year group and staff attached to each house chose a House winner. The overall was won by Yr4 Butser House - who gave us a super rendition of "Leisure" by W.H. Davis, complete with actions.

I feel, as a group of schools, we were ahead of the game on this. 
