
Christmas Themed Mufti Day – Friday 30th November

DoodleMaths Update

We are delighted that so many of our Parents have taken up this wonderful offer from DoodleMaths. We hope you have now received your login letter but if you haven't or are having trouble logging in, then please contact the school office. We are also pleased to announce that DoodleMaths have given us access to DoodleTables, which can to be downloaded as an app, for our pupils as well.

In order to secure this great discount, we have created a Premium School account. However, this might cause confusion as some functionality (such as GAP Analysis through the Parent Dashboard) is only available for schools to use. To view your child's progress from home, DoodleMaths have provided the following instructions:



Step 2 - Click on 'Grown ups' area and follow the instructions to create parent account.

Step 3 - Download the parent app to your mobile phone.

Step 4 - Log in to the parent app on your phone and "ignore" the upgrade to Premium because your child is linked to the school and it is unnecessary.

Step 5 - Click your child's name to see everything - all time stars, accuracy, DoodleAge, strengths and weaknesses currently identified and being worked on within the app (this is the Parent version of GAP Analysis you might see on other devices).

Step 6 - Should you wish to support your child with extra work in identified areas of weakness - click on grown-ups within the pupil app. Click lesson index (you have full access to content here which you have been given access to as a result of the School purchasing DoodleMaths)
