Running Track – Latest News



Some parents and carers will have seen the Petersfield Post article this week, which spoke of some funding which might achieve the installation of an all-weather community running track right here at Herne. It is true that we are in negotiations for this funding, but we have yet to secure the funds and wouldn't like to assume a foregone conclusion.

Once it is clear what the next stage is, we'll keep everyone posted and give an idea of timescales involved. As stated before, we are incredibly grateful for all of the community support for this project, not least from our local runners, The RunnyHoneys.

Funding Update

As the country holds its collective breath over the political drama in the House of Commons, we are pleased to report that at least two questions over the school funding crisis were asked at Prime Ministers Question Time this week.

Mr Markham works with Jules White, the West Sussex headteacher who has worked so hard on this issue, and welcomed him to talk to all Hampshire headteachers at their annual conference in Southampton today.

If you haven't had a chance to do so, it isn't too late to write to your local MP about the funding issues as detailed below:

Current Concerns

- Since 2010 school budgets have been reduced in real terms by 8% and by 20% at post-16
- Class sizes are rising and the curricular offer is being restricted
- Increasingly, schools are being asked to support with children's emotional health and wellbeing. Frequently, we do not have adequate resource to meet a growing need.
- Often, the most vulnerable pupils in our schools – those from disadvantaged backgrounds or those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) – are bearing the brunt of cuts and schools are struggling to provide the levels of support that they are entitled to.
