## INSET Days for 2018 to 2019 Academic Year

After some feedback to the infant school and via Facebook, we realised that parents were a little perplexed as to why two of our

INSET days for next academic year do not tie up with our infant colleagues. First of all, we have always historically tried to make sure every single INSET day is in-line with each other, but next academic year we have some other staff development that we need to schedule at a different time to the infants.

The three days that are the same are: Mon Sep 3<sup>rd</sup>, Tues 4<sup>th</sup> & in 2019 Mon Jan 7<sup>th</sup>.

We have two days that are different. On Mon Nov 19<sup>th</sup> there is a whole-school review which needs to be timed further into the autumn term (not on the first two days) as we strive to improve reading for every single child in the school with our Compulsory Acceleration Programme. On Monday Jun 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019, we are joining Purbrook Juniors and Liss Juniors to do some collaborative

work on junior school development. This involves an outside agency who we have had to book in for that date. We hope that parents and carers understand our reasons for this change from the usual arrangements.

## **Pupil Premium**

## Message from Anwen Foy (Virtual School Executive Headteacher for Hampshire)



**Dear Parents and Guardians** 

You may be aware that children who were adopted from local authority care or who have left care under a special guardianship or care arrangements order (formally known as a residence order), are eligible to attract the pupil premium. The pupil premium is an additional sum (currently worth £2,300 per pupil) to help provide specific support to raise attainment and address the wider needs of vulnerable children. The links below will take you to the current DfE 'Conditions of Grant' and the Virtual School's Frequently Asked Questions which explain more about this funding and what it is for.

If you wish your child's school to claim the pupil premium on their behalf, you will need to let the school know that your child was adopted from care or left care under a guardianship or care arrangements order. This information will then be included in the January school Census, triggering payment of pupil premium to the school. You will be asked to provide evidence, for example, a copy of the adoption order. This will be kept confidential in accordance with data protection legislation. You may also want to take the opportunity to discuss with the Head Teacher or appropriate member of staff, your wishes around any specific sharing of this information. We hope you will find this information useful.
