
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# Finding Your Child's Class and Teacher at Herne Junior School 2018 – 2019

## **EARLY FINISH REGISTRATION PROTOCOL**

As our annual review of policies begins in earnest, we would like to draw your attention to an amendment to our Attendance Policy regarding the last day of each term, when we finish a little earlier. The school usually closes at 12.30pm on these days. The reason for this is due to the statutory amount of curriculum time we have to give to children at Key Stage 2. Herne has always provided more time than legally required, so the small measure of redressing this imbalance is to finish earlier on the three 'end-of-term days' each academic year. On these days, children will be registered at 8.50am and at 12pm. If your child is absent on this day, they will be recorded as having missed two sessions. This means that any full week unauthorised absence will be recorded as 10 unauthorised sessions. Therefore, if no satisfactory explanation can be provided for the absence, parents will be liable for a Penalty Notice from the Local Authority for unauthorised absence. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in this matter. All schools in England are now required to follow this approach to unauthorised absence. If you are in any doubt about your child being out of school in term time, please speak to us in the first instance and as soon as you know of the possibility of an absence. Thank you.

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#### Attendance & Lateness

Attendance and lateness are monitored regularly. Our aim is for at least 95+% attendance for all our pupils and consider attendance under 90% to be a concern. Arriving at school on time is just as important. Class registers are taken at 8.50am. All minutes late are recorded on your child's record. Please make sure that you send your child in everyday unless they are unwell. We will always inform you if your child becomes unwell at school. Please leave a message on the School's absence line when you child is unwell. We have to record the day as unauthorised if we do not hear from you. Please try and book all medical appointments during school holidays or after school



where possible. Finally, holidays cannot be authorised during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. Requests must be made using the appropriate form which can be found in our Reception area. Please note that any unauthorised absences or persistent lateness may result in parents being issued with a Penalty Notice which could lead to a fine from the Local Authority.

#### Park & Stride Scheme: Permits



We have now renewed the parking permits for parents and carers to use to park in the Love Lane car park near the football club and in the Festival Hall car park. This permit is FREE and gives parents time to walk from the car park to the school and back. There are two types of permit: one for junior school parents only and another for parents who have a child at the infant school. This joint permit allows parents a little extra time for parking due to the pick-up from two schools. We are grateful to East Hants District Council for supporting this scheme

and it really helps to keep the traffic from the school's local roads, as well as the added health benefits that come with walking to school.

## **Drop Off First Thing in the Mornings**

Supervision at Herne is very important to us and we have an arrangement to supervise children from 8.30am onwards. We are increasingly getting scores of children turning up well before this time and this is a huge risk to the safety of the children who are here before they should be. If parents need to drop off early, please use our Breakfast Club, which is a facility run by the school as a not-for-profit set-up costing £3 a session (including breakfast). Children who arrive too early will be noted and we will be in touch with families to resolve the situation in order to safeguard the children. We hope you understand.

## **Homework Policy Review**

Parents and carers may be pleased to know that we have listened to your feedback about the larger homework projects that have involved 'making things'. As much as some families love this kind of thing, there are many other families that find these projects time-consuming (on top of the normal homework expectations) or don't have the



materials, time or expertise to create a masterpiece of engineering! We have now asked year teams to keep these type of projects down to a maximum of TWO A YEAR. This means that those who love this sort of thing can still do their thing and others who find it a struggle, don't worry...we understand!

## **Parent Governor Vacancy**

We have a vacancy for a parent to join our Governing Body and would welcome applications from any parent who has an interest in our school. A governor helps to set the strategic direction of the school and calls the leadership to account for the performance of the school. It is a really interesting and varied role that would require some time commitment for attending meetings, usually from 5.15pm onwards. There are also opportunities to see at first hand the inner workings of your child's school and, where appropriate, to influence what we do. We are particularly looking for parents who may have a financial background or interest, especially in the light of the budget challenges ahead.
