Message from the Headteacher

It has been an extraordinary week for us all, as we have watched news items that have reported on the passage of The Queen's journey towards her final resting place. We have also seen many items and programmes celebrating the life our longest serving monarch. The new King, Charles III, was officially proclaimed King at a ceremony led by the Accession Council last Saturday. I visited London on that day with my wife to lay flowers at Green Park and accidently became caught up with the crowds outside of Clarence House where we saw The King as he got out of his car to meet the crowds. A moment in history.



I'm told that The King scurried in and very excitedly told his entourage that he'd met Mr and Mrs Markham! What an honour! All joking aside, one of his first tasks was to announce a **Bank Holiday for this coming Monday**, 19th **September** to enable us all to

witness the State Funeral of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. This means that our school will be closed from the end of today until Tuesday morning. As a mark of respect, I have told all staff that we will halt all email exchanges until we

reopen on Tuesday, so if we receive any emails over the Bank Holiday weekend, please don't be surprised if you do not get a reply until next week. Thank you.

If you come into our school over the coming weeks, you'll see the special display in our foyer to mark this moment in time. Our thanks go to Mrs Lynne Tandy (our IT Technician) who has provided fresh flowers for the display.

COVID Infections

Just a quick note to all parents and carers that we have received confirmation this week of some pupils who have tested positive for COVID-19. It feels like a long time ago that we were managing these situations and it was having a huge impact on attendance of both staff and pupils. If you suspect that your child is not well with COVID symptoms, then please let us know if you have a positive confirmation of this. The current rules are that children will need three days out of school and adults five days. The situation nationally is that infection rates are at their lowest since the pandemic began and that the World Health Organisation are considering downgrading COVID from a pandemic (world-wide event) to an epidemic in those countries worst affected. If your child is at home and well enough, we still have Home Learning materials posted on our website under the 'Children' tab.

School Clubs List - Starting in October

As a school, we have been very busy this month with a recruitment process for the headteacher post and preparing for a new office post for either an Admin Officer or Business Manager. Alongside this, we have had to change the way we access pupil information; a change forced upon us by the school data company we use (SIMS). This has delayed some of our systems for dealing with things



outside of the school day, including clubs. We are now in a better position with the admin systems, so will be collating a wider provision of clubs, which we will advertise at the end of this month with a view to many of them starting this side of half-term. CM clubs have started, music tuition and Rocksteady have also started, so our school-run clubs will add to this provision. Thank you for your patience during this period of transition.

Football Trials

This is for any children who would like to join the Boy's Year 5 & 6 Football Club and the Girl's Year 5 & 6 Football Club (which will be on Friday's afterschool 3.30 – 4.30pm). We will be holding trials next week on:

Wednesday Lunchtime (21st September)

Boots and shin pads must NOT be worn for this trial. Year 5 will already be in PE kit, but Year 6 can bring their PE kit to get changed into. The potential players are to meet the teachers out on the school field at the start of the lunchtime. A message will be sent round before lunchtime to remind the relevant children. If your child is successful, the club will start on Friday 23rd September. Mr Castle is hoping to open the club to Year 4 girls as well, but first needs to check numbers who come to the trial in the upper school.

School Photos - Next Tuesday 20th September

The school traditionally makes sure we have a photo of every child in our school, which helps us to identify everyone by sight, especially if they have any special considerations (e.g. medical needs etc.) Please ensure your child has a school shirt and jumper or cardigan. If Tuesday is a PE day for your child, would parents please ensure their child has a school uniform t-shirt and jumper/cardigan for your child to change into briefly for the photos. They are only a picture of head and torso, so don't worry about changing out of shorts or joggers. Thank you.


Meet the Teachers (Years 5 and 6) - Reminder

Year 6 – TUESDAY 20th September 3.40pm


Year 5 - WEDNESDAY 21st September 3.40pm
