We would like you to develop your word knowledge even more. Look up the following words and write a sentence using them.

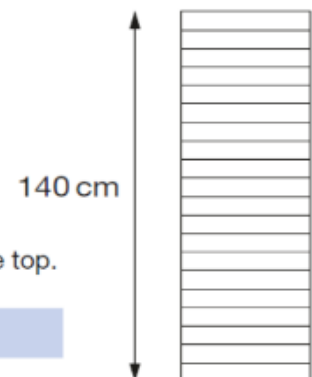
