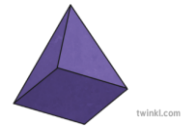
Maths: Speedy Six

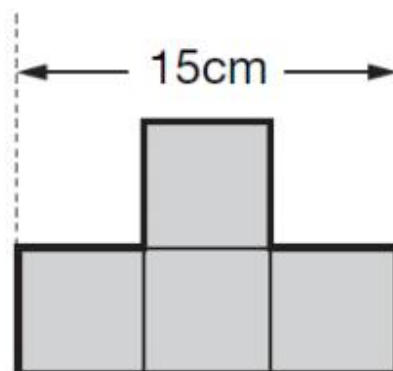
