

### Maths:

Place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, money, angles, reasoning tasks, written methods for the 4 operations, measure, perimeter, different types of lines, multiplying by 10 and 100, purple pen questions, using APE to answer reasoning tasks.

### Science:

Rocks and soils - making a volcano and erupting it, designing soil cocktail

Magnets - which is the strongest magnet? Which metals are magnetic? What materials in our classroom are magnetic?

Plants - the functions of different parts of a plant, what is the stem used for? What are the best conditions for seeds to germinate?
