## **Annual Renewal Summary (Years 4, 5 & 6)**



At Herne Junior School we strive to get to know your child incredibly well (Knowing Every Child).

We know their happiness links to their capacity to learn and links to the happiness of their family.

It is only in partnership with parents and carers that we can achieve the best for your child by working closely together.

Here is a summary of some simple things that will make your child's time at Herne a happy and successful experience.

- Parents should help their child achieve physical and emotional well-being by ensuring they have a good bed time routine, appropriate lunch/snacks, excellent attendance and arrive punctually at school in order to maximise their learning.
- Children must adhere to the homework agreement, homework must be completed to an expected standard and handed in on time. Children should read at least 5 times a week for a minimum period of 10 minutes.
- ❖ Where children are not reading at their Age Related Expectation for their year group, if selected, they must attend the Compulsory Acceleration Programme during the first part of the day BEFORE school (8.10 registration) Mondays to Thursdays (Fridays are optional). Parents will be informed by letter if their child is required to do C.A.P.
- For Year 4 children, if identified for extra support with their phonics, your child will be invited to attend before school support (from 8.30am) to continue using Read, Write, Inc. interventions.
- Children must be sent to school in full, correct uniform, not trainers, with no jewellery, nail polish or extreme hairstyles and with long hair tied back.
- Children must have a full PE kit and a water bottle in school at all times.
- ❖ Parents must support the school in enforcing its Good Behaviour Policy.
- Parents should attend parents' evenings on a regular basis to check on their child's progress and endeavour to maintain open communication with the school. Grievances should be brought to the attention of the school and not aired over social media.
- ❖ COVID-19 Update If your child's Bubble or the whole school is Locked Down, then our expectation is that your child continues to access their education through our Remote Home Learning Support during that period when they can't be physically in school.
- ❖ COVID-19 Update Some of the arrangements in normal times may need to be adjusted if face-to-face contact cannot be maintained, e.g. Parents' Evenings going online via video.
