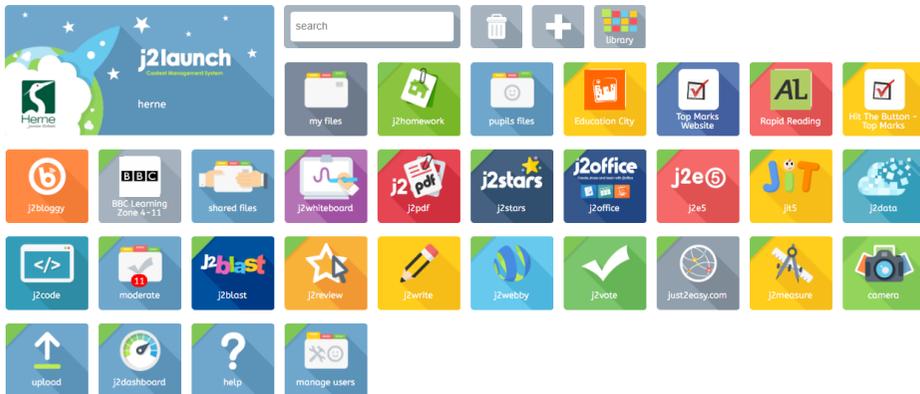


How to upload files to J2e

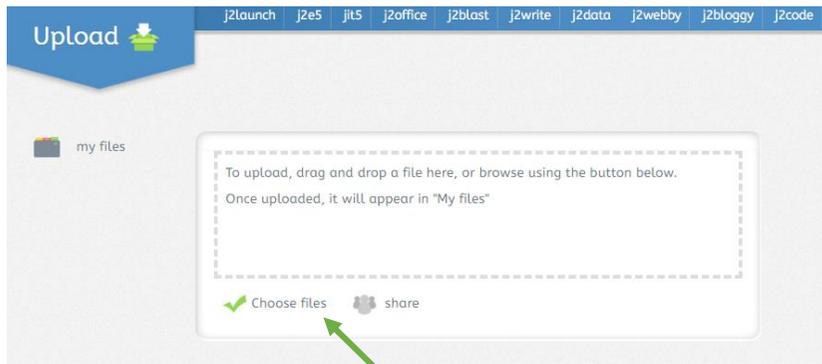
If you are uploading a file from **outside** of J2e

1. Click on the **upload** tab



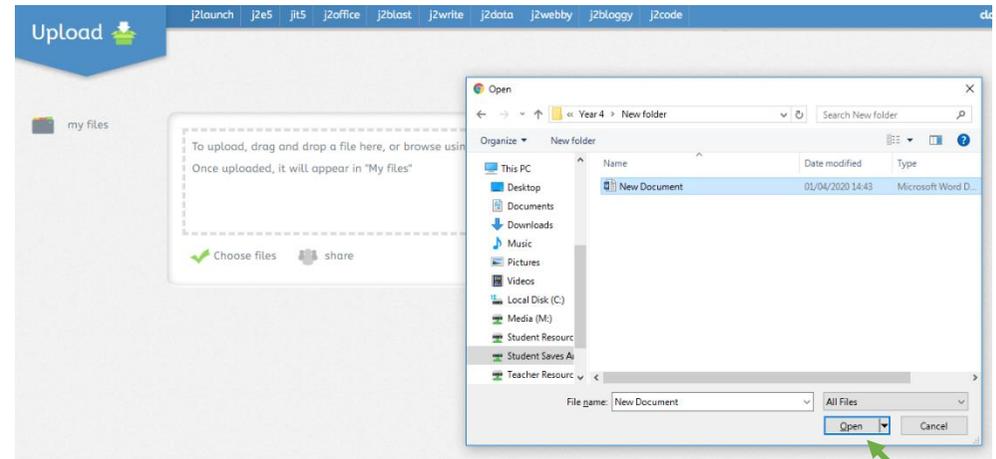
This might appear in a different location on the Home screen.

2. This page will load.



3. Click on **Choose Files**

4. The "open" file screen will load.



5. Choose your file from where ever it is saved. Click **open**. (This can be any type of document).



6. The file will now be uploaded

To share a document on J2e with your teacher

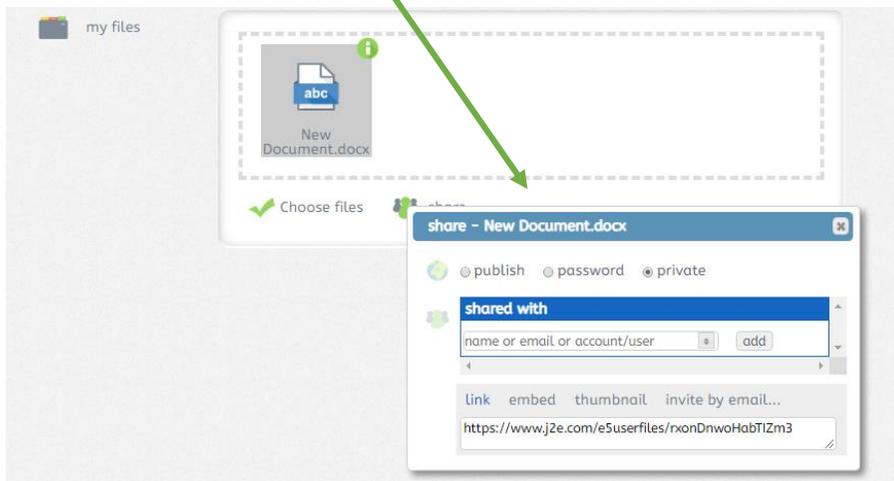
To **share** a document you have just **uploaded**.

NB: you will need to "share" documents individually, (1 at a time).

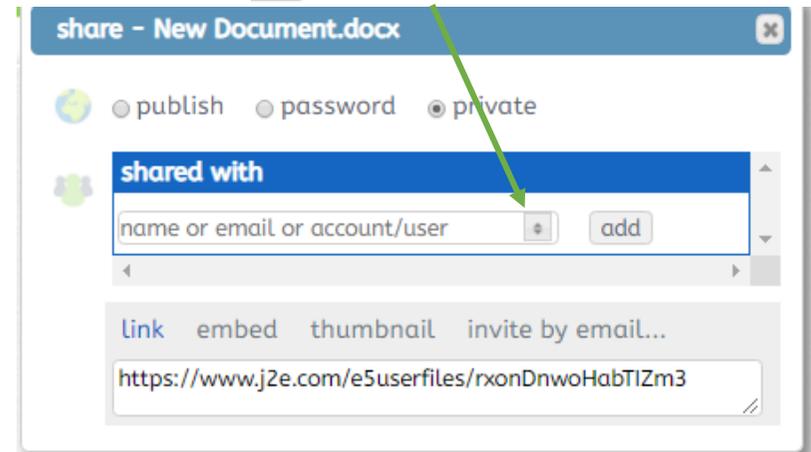
1. Click on the document you want to share.



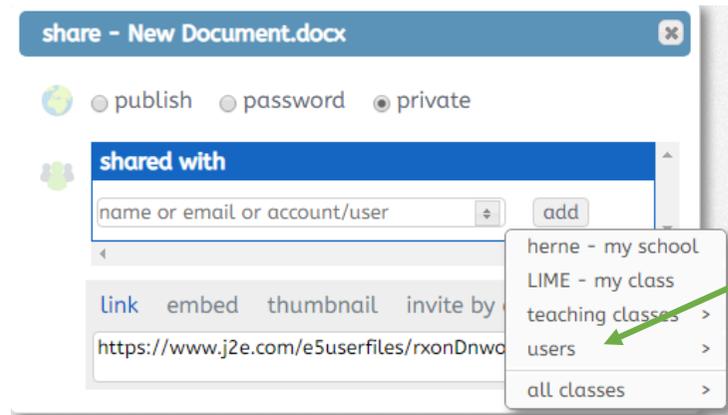
2. Click on **share** 
3. This screen will open.



4. Click on the small  arrows

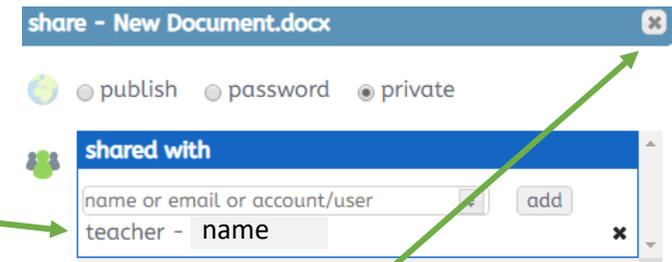


5. Click on **users**



6. From this, a list of teachers will appear - select your teacher.

7. Your teacher's name will appear below the "Shared with" box.



8. Your document has now been shared. You can press the  to come out.

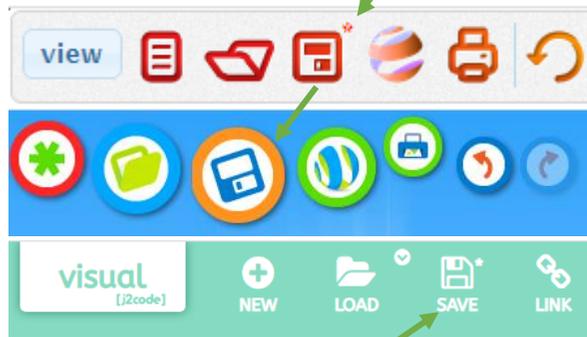
To save & share a document on J2e with your teacher

If you are working **within** a programme of J2e and need to **save** your work.

1. Depending which programme you have been working on in J2e, will depend on the "save" button you see.



Most of the time it will be a "floppy disk" symbol top left of your screen. **Click** on it.



2. The "save" screen will appear.

3. Type in a "title" for your document.

4. It is a good idea to include your name and the objective of the work in the "title" of the document.

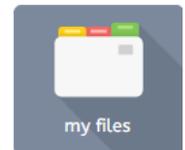
5. **Click** on Save.  Your document is now saved!
